FACILITY USE POLICIES Gurney Lane Mtn. Bike Park & Recreation Area

Outline of policies:

<u>Informal Group Rides</u>: Trails can be used informally as a way to meet and organize group rides to enjoy the sport of mtn. biking – no special permission is needed ahead of time. If this informal use grows larger in popularity to include more than 25 riders, training equipment is used, group signage or storage trailers are used or if additional spaces are needed (i.e. lower field, pavilions, facilities), reaching out to Queensbury Parks and Recreation to request space and to let them know, is required.

Organized Camps/Clinics: If an organization or individual wants to publicly advertise clinics, camps or other kinds of structured events or gatherings and/or if a registration fee is being charged to attend or participate or open spaces/pavilions/tents are desired, they must reach out to Queensbury Parks & Recreation first to receive written permission. Part of this process requires an insurance certificate with a liability policy that names the Town of Queensbury as an additional insured for the duration of the event/gathering. Additionally, a small rental/reservation fee may also be charged to host the event/camp/clinic at the Gurney Lane/Gurney South facilities.
